Our Pastoral Care ministry is in need of urgent material resources for this family:

Gabriel and Asia Vasileniuc, along with their three children: Emi (7), Miriam (6) and Emma (2). This family of national workers has been hosted in the pastoral care room of our church indefinitely. The economical crisis has hit them really hard, affecting both their ministry and family life. They are currently unemployed and without a personal ministry, for which reason they will take a breather and spend some restoration time under my mentorship and pastoral counseling. Gabriel was my first disciple when I arrived to Romania. He studied and graduated from the Biblical seminary which I directed and taught and was under my tutorship as a national missionary. Gabriel is Romanian and his wife is from Transdnistria, Republic of Moldova, bordering Ukraine, which is still under Russian occupancy.



Their room does not have a heating system and this winter is forecasted to be the coldest for the past 1000 years in Europe. We ask for your donations to supply a wood based heater, a rug for the room and logs. The total cost will add up to \$950.

My wife, Dalila, will be helping out with the children's schooling, taking care of their material needs, teaching them good manners, and helping out with first grade studies.
