Two years ago a newlywed couple was expelled from their home church due to rebellion. Their church was one of the best in Brasov, focused on evangelism and growth.

They were youth leaders and one of the most active evangelizers in the city of Brasov. Their expulsion caused division within the church and many of their youth decided to no longer assist the church services. The church has not yet fully recovered.

They both, not only abandoned the church but also the Christian faith and are now professing to be believers in the new age of the "law of attraction", denying the authority of the inspiration of the Bible, the divinity of Christ and the existence of a personal God.

Three weeks ago he called me and invited out to lunch. Since then, we have been having lunch every Tuesday in order to sit down and talk. Our last meeting was important due to the fact that we debated the Christian faith, the Bible's authority, as well as God's jealousy for him.

All across Europe God is fighting a battle of faith.

His mission is not only to rescue the unreached, but also every prodigal son.

Each and every one of us matters.

In Brasov, when the Evangelical Churches begin to influence society, their leaders, as well as the church, is being attacked without mercy. Many of those attacks come from inside, which prevents the prosperity of the churches.

In the mean time, Europe is on a sure path to hell!

Battles we never expected to fight

In April of 1999, after 5 years of our fruitful ministry in Brasov, due to unforeseen and out of our control circumstances, we were forced to abandon our ministry in only two weeks and suddenly leave Romania along with all our family, not knowing if we would be able to return.



Our children, Debby (10years old), Elisa (9years old), and Ruben (8years old), cried over having to suddenly abandon, their home and their adoptive country which they loved as their own.

All of us remember when our children's dog ran after the car that was taking us to the airport. We were leaving her with the hope of being able to come back.

The need to lose in order to gain

All of a sudden we lost our main economic support. The incoming support from the churches in El Salvador was little, which was not sufficient enough to convince us to stay in Romania.

A miracle began to take place

We returned to El Salvador and we dedicated ourselves to sharing our vision, trusting that God had given us the calling to go to Romania and that He would confirm that through His provision.

It was then that a miracle began to take place as family members, friends of the ministry, pastors and other brothers in Christ around the country began to call us up and invite us to their churches, making a commitment to support us.

After having heard our report, our sending church and our pastors unanimously expressed they solidarity and commitment to send us back to Romania.

The impossible was made possible

We returned to Romania on January of 2000. Since then brothers belonging to churches from different countries, have participated in our ministry in alliance with our sending church Miramonte Baptist Church and our Mission Board Global Outreach International.

The battles continue today in other fronts

The needs remain high, for both: monthly family support and ministry. Making plans and budgets has been a difficult and risky task for we never know how much support will be coming in each month. But with the faith and trust that the Holy Spirit gives us through the Word, we persevere and continue enjoying the blessings from God.

Evangelizing each person

Dalila is taking the task of evangelizing the women around our community. One of our neighbors has become very interested and invites Dalila to her place weekly. Dalila takes the opportunity to buy eggs, rabbit or other natural products from her and which she produces.

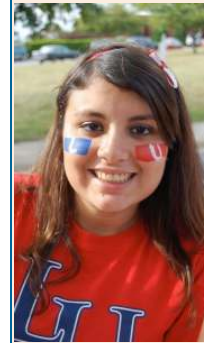


Debora Dalila
