We started in our country as national missionaries of “Miramonte Baptist Church”, our sending church.

Later, after nine years of ministry in a local church that we had founded, we were ready to leave as missionaries to Romania, but we had no funds. One night, a young couple from “New Life Baptist Church” came to our home and gave us a donation. It was the exact amount we needed for the plane tickets.

We left El Salvador in 1994 with the support of few churches and with a very small budget.

We arrived in Kansas City, MO, where we spent one year in missionary training and serving in the Hispanic ministry of KCBT Church.

In 1995, with the support of relatives, friends, KCBT and other churches from Central America, Canada and

USA, our dream came true. We arrived to Romania with three little children.

God helped us learn the language and culture. Our children have studied and finished High School in the Romanian public schools.

From 1995 to 1999 we developed a discipleship ministry, a Bible Institute, Sunday school classes and helped many rural churches.

From 2000 to present, we have established a local urban church, as well as helped to establish and develop other churches. We have provided counseling, trained leaders and pastors and Dalila has developed the Gypsy children ministry.
